This is an urgent newsflash to all our readers who claim home office expenses. As you know from last edition the ATO has changed the rules of the game and they require you to keep a diary from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 for the whole year, every year. We have created a spreadsheet to help you comply with the new requirements for the hourly rate. It is also useful in keeping the necessary records to utilise the actual cost method instead. All explained in the spreadsheet, but you need to face up to it NOW! And please spread the word, anyone who doesn't find out about this until they visit their Accountant to do their 2023 tax return will miss out on the claim for both 2023 and 2024.
